I am a senior lecturer at Queen Mary University of London and an assistant professor at Panteion University in Athens and I share my time between the two countries. At Panteion I act as the official representative for ECPR. My forthcoming book with C. Moury, D. Cardoso and A.Gago, *Capitalising on Constraint: Bailout Politics in Eurozone Countries* will be soon out from Manchester University Press.

I have been acting as the co-convenor of the Greek Politics Specialist Group (GPSG) of the Political Studies Association (PSA) for four years. This is a group of approximately 400 members internationally. By running GPSG, I have gained administrative experience and I have enjoyed the results of collegiality and collaboration. I have been participating at ECPR events from the beginning of my academic career. This year, I am co-chairing with Simona Piattoni the section on *Politics of Austerity, Redistribution and the Future of Welfare States* at the ECPR SGEU virtual conference. I would love to serve at the ECPR executive committee since I am passionate about its purpose and values. I feel that this the time for me to offer to the European political science community what I had the privilege to enjoy during less turbulent times.
